On May 16th 2017 the voters of Bonneville County endorsed the importance of education in the eastern Idaho region through the creation of the College of Eastern Idaho Taxing District. CEI was formed and a fully comprehensive community college mission was added to our region. The technical mission of EITC remains intact and vibrant, but the creation of two associate transfer degrees now permits students of CEI to complete the first two years of a bachelor's degree and transfer those credits into universities. 
in the Navy saving for college and wasn't able to attend. He was my biggest cheerleader."

Each year, a mass of colorful teams descends on Snake River Landing. This is the annual Great Race for Education. The true goal is to raise money for the CEI Foundation; however, on the day of the race, all anyone really wants to do is win. It's a race against time to solve the clues, complete the challenges, and return to base.

The event actually begins with PreRace the week before. This gives teams the chance to win an advantage to be used on the day of the race. Teams solve clues directing them to locations around Downtown Idaho Falls where they can find items to help them get a foot up.

This year, the theme was Passport to Education. The teams faced a series of challenges ranging across downtown Idaho Falls, making sure to get their 'passport' stamped at each location. After the initial race, the field of competition is narrowed down to the top teams. The remaining teams then compete in a series of minuteto-win-it style games. This year teams played classics such as The Tortilla Toss, where one teammate would catch a tortilla launched by another teammate wearing flippers, and The Clumsy Elephant, which consisted of knocking water bottles over with a tennis ball hanging from a stocking on the racer's head.

Team Cooper Norman took first place. Team Progrexion took second, with Team Fluor Idaho following in third. By the end of the day, the exhausted and satisfied groups settled down to eat and rehydrate.

As exciting as the competition is, the teams never forget their true goal. This event is one that brings everyone together to help CEI students and raise scholarship money.
